Get the birthday kid involved in the decorating by making this tissue paper centerpiece/wall hanging together! Once you cut out the number and the tissue paper, the birthday boy/girl can help crumple the paper and glue the resulting puffs down. There are so many fun colors of tissue paper at Dollar Tree, you'll be sure to find some that go with your theme. Plus, it will be super cute hanging in their room until it's time to make a new one next year!

Shop at Dollar Tree – Here's What You'll Need:

- 1 Sheet of Foam Board
- 1 Pack of Tissue Paper to Coordinate with Your Party Décor
- Glue

Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

- 1. Cut the birthday kid's age out of the foam board.
- 2. Cut or tear 3–5 sheets of tissue paper into roughly 3" squares.
- 3. Crumple each tissue square and glue to the number.
- 4. Let dry and hang as a wreath on the door or prop on a plate stand to set on a table. (Tip: wrap the plate stand with the same tissue paper for a fun and finished look.)

• Throwing a wedding shower or baby shower? Instead of a number, cut a letter out of the foam board to represent the new baby's initials or the couple-to-be's monogram!
