



Bottle Cap Snowman Ornaments

Let's face it... we would LOVE to have that Norman Rockwell handmade kind of holiday, but the reality is everyone ends up rushing around from shopping to get-togethers to cooking to more shopping. Take back some holiday fun with this clever idea... and even the busiest of the busy can whip up a few of these adorable little guys. They're so amazingly easy, fun, and cheap to make that you can create a whole army of them to give as gifts, decorate your tree, or even use as gift tie-ons in no time flat! Plus, this kid-friendly craft is also fun for adults, so it's perfect for a rainy day or family fun night.

Shop at Dollar Tree – Here's What You'll Need:

- Bottle Caps, 3 for Each Ornament
- Ribbon
- White Paint (nail polish works well and is durable, but acrylic paint or correction fluid will also work)
- Permanent Markers, Glitter Glue, or Black and Orange Paint
- Glue
- Scissors



Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

1. Paint the insides of the bottle caps white. It may take a few coats to get good, even coverage.
2. For each ornament, draw a face on one bottle cap, "coat buttons" on the second bottle cap, and leave the third bottle cap solid white.
3. Cut a 6" piece of ribbon. Glue your snowman pieces to the ribbon. Fold over the remaining ribbon at the top into a loop and glue in place to make your hanger.
4. Use a small piece of ribbon to tie between the top and middle bottle caps as a scarf.
