

Crackled Ice Vases

Wintery, snowy days are beautiful... that blanket of snow and ice makes everything look sparkling and clean. If only it didn't melt when you brought it inside... Well, with a little white paint, glue, and Epsom salts (they're not just for relaxing baths!), you can transform recycled jars and vases into cool and modern decorative accents that will stay icy fresh all winter long.

Shop at Dollar Tree - Here's What You'll Need:

- Vases, Glassware, Recycled Jars, or Bottles
- White Paint
- · White Glue
- Epsom Salts

Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

- 1. Paint the glassware white. It may take a few coats to get a smooth, opaque look.
- 2. Once dry, apply white glue to a portion of your vase, and then roll it in Epsom salts.
- 3. Shake off the excess salt and allow it to dry.
- 4. Display on its own or add faux flowers, twigs, or bamboo for a stylish touch.

Fun Tip:

You can also use white glue and tissue paper to cover the glass in white — just thin the glue with
water and adhere white tissue paper to your glassware, smoothing over the last layer with a little
of the glue mixture.
