## Monster Luminaries



Light up the night with these fun luminaries! Recycle old jars or use vases, votive holders, or glassware to line the walkway to your front door. Not a fan of pumpkin carving? These are a fun alternative to traditional pumpkins, plus they'll look great on your front porch, hallway table, or mantel. Let them glow with our LED tealights or, for something even brighter, check out the electronics section of our stores for closet, book, or table lights. Glow sticks also make for great candle alternatives.

### Shop at Dollar Tree – Here's What You'll Need:

- Vases, Jars, Candleholders, and Glasses (anything with a fun shape!)
- Tissue Paper
- Black Construction Paper
- White Glue
- LED Lights or Glow Sticks

### Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

1. Rip tissue paper into strips.
2. In a shallow dish, mix 2 parts white glue to 1 part water.
3. Coat small sections of clean glassware at a time with the glue mixture, place tissue strips on top of the glue, and carefully smooth them down. Repeat until the glassware is completely covered.
4. When dry, cut spooky and fun faces out of the construction paper and glue them down. Add a final layer of the glue mixture on top of the entire lantern and allow to dry.
